Stephanie has also completed the Robert Zoller Certificate in Medieval Astrology.

American/Australian astrology Martin Lass has written the Chiron (planet of Healing) interpretations in this report, as well as the general overview of each of the planets. He is a renowned astrologer (www.martinlass.com/astrohom2.htm) specializing in spiritual and healing astrology and is one of the world's leading experts on Chiron, the planet of Healing. His definitive book about Chiron, "Chiron - Healing Body and Soul," was published by Llewellyn Worldwide in 2005.

The Chiron interpretations in this report come from the perspective of spiritual and personal development, self-knowledge in the esoteric meaning of the phrase, and Healing taken in the broadest sense as meaning the journey of becoming Whole once more, or, to put another way, the awakening to and return to Source.

NORTH NODE (General)

Your life's path consists of where you have come from, represented by the South Node of the Moon, and where you are going, represented by the North Node of the Moon. In addition, your life's path has two other elements: who you are and why you are here.

Taken together, these four factors add up to your Divine Design. Your Divine Design amounts to the very thing(s) you would most love to be, do, and have in your life,

although these things may be hidden at first under your unhealed and unresolved wounds and issues. Discovering, embracing, and finally manifesting your Divine Design is part of the healing and evolutionary journey of your life's path.

The South Node is about the past; it tells you what you bring into this lifetime in terms of gifts, talents, and lessons learned, as well as setting out lessons and issues still to be worked through.

The North Node tells you what your new challenges and aims are, as well setting out what your unique service and gift to others will be as you increasingly manifest your Divine Design.

In this way, the North Node is about your destiny, manifested through a particular calling or vocation.

Taken together, the North and South Nodes represent your quest for wholeness--your quest to become a more complete human being.

THE NORTH NODE IN AQUARIUS

This is a quest towards service to humankind. You will experience a struggle between your own personal needs and a sense of dedication to others. You need to lay aside your personal need for honor and prestige and use your talents to serve the world.

THE NORTH NODE IN THE 7TH HOUSE

This is a quest for right relations. You need to let go of ego-centred actions and devote your life to others.

THE SUN (General)

You express, live out, and manifest your life's path (seen primarily through the Moon's Nodes) through your Sun sign.

The Sun is about your identity, how you express yourself, your creative urges, your ego on the one hand, and your highest spiritual nature on the other hand. It mirrors the ways in which you allow yourself to shine (or not).

As an icon, the Sun represents the potential unification of your lower natures (physical, emotional, and mental). These natures are otherwise and for the most part separate from each other, unaligned, and scattered in terms of consciousness; this is despite the common misperception that these lower natures are more or less unified and aligned with each other.

Ego arises from this lack of unity and alignment and from our misperceptions concerning this lack. Conversely, spiritual growth comes when we wake up to this lack and then strive to align and unify our lower natures into a higher expression of our essential divinity.

The Sun also represents your potential to wake up to a greater reality, to come alive, and to celebrate the joy and gift of your existence. In its highest expression, the Sun represents unconditional Love.

THE SUN IN PISCES

You are an imaginative and serene individual. You need to express your fantasies and imagination, and may be a dreamer or be ungrounded.

THE SUN IN THE 10TH HOUSE

You shine in the public arena. Profession, social status and marital status become the lens through which you will express yourself.

THE MOON (General)

The Moon represents your earliest childhood emotional experiences, patterns, programming, and protective mechanisms. It mirrors your lower natures--physical, emotional, and mental--when these are not yet aligned, integrated, or unified and when these natures react immaturely rather than acting maturely.

When things gets challenging, when you are backed into a corner, when you become overwhelmed by external events or circumstances, or when your buttons are pushed, your Moon sign determines how you react and where you "go" in response.

In this way, the Moon is also your safety valve, your safe haven, your mother's skirts, so to speak, and your shell of protection, particularly protecting you from having to deal with your deepest wounds and issues before you are ready to do so. In this way, the Moon is the "exterior face" of Chiron, which, in turn, is the planet of your deepest wounds and of your greatest potential for healing.

Generally, the Moon mirrors your mother and/or the female side of your family; it mirrors how you perceive you were nurtured (or not) and your resulting expectations. In turn, this determines the ways in which you nurture others (or not), particularly with respect to your intimate partners and your children (if you have any).

From a higher perspective, the Moon, being the planet that deals with your immature and unevolved lower natures, constantly points you to where you are in need of

growth, transformation, integration, alignment, and unification. This is the Moon's higher gift, alongside the usual benefits it offers in terms of safety and protection.

THE MOON IN SAGITTARIUS

You have an emotional need for adventure and independence, and an instinctual urge for travel and exploring. Under stress you will want to go on an adventure. Your mother may be seen as fun-loving and independent.

THE MOON IN THE 5TH HOUSE

Having fun and being creative are the best ways for you to look after yourself. You need recreation. Children may also provide a source of comfort.

Part of Body: Right iliac vein

MERCURY (General)

Mercury is the planet of communication, the intellect, common sense, commerce, business, mass media, entertainment, and humor. It is about versatility, movement, and fluidity, particularly of thought.

Mercury, being the lower octave expression of Uranus, is about making local connections and creating local networks, both internally in your psyche and externally among your contacts. It is about temporary alliances and interactions. And it is about the exchange of ideas, opinions, and perspectives, even if these may change from one minute to the next.

Mercury is also about mental attractions and repulsions--the things that drive you toward or away from places, things, and people in your life. In this way, Mercury ensures that your life is rich and varied, although it may eventually become apparent that your ordinary life sometimes remains in the same general vicinity and/or travels in circles.

In this way, Mercury is also about mental habits, beliefs, opinions, stances, and judgments.

As with Moon, Venus, and Mars, Mercury represents one of your lower natures; in this case, it represents your lower mental nature.

MERCURY IN ARIES

You are an independent thinker. You talk quickly, and like to think up new ideas. You may experience flashes of intuition.

MERCURY IN THE 10TH HOUSE

You may seek a career in communications or education. You will be keen to share your thoughts and ideas in your chosen profession.

4TH DEGREE OF ARIES

Part of Body: Pineal Gland

Sabian Symbol: Two lovers strolling through a secluded walk.

CONJUNCTION SATURN Orb 1°02' Applying

You have a logical mind. As a child you were shy and unable to express your opinions.

As an adult you will become a voice of authority.

VENUS (General)

Venus is the planet of earthly love, relationship, companionship, beauty, grace, proportion, equity, and balance. It is about emotional attractions and repulsions, which drive you along your life's path.

Venus is also about what you value, so is therefore linked with money, resources, and creature comforts.

As the planet of relationships, Venus's love is actually polarized. That is, it divides the world up into where love is apparent and visible and where love is not apparent and/or hidden. This means that Venus's love, although very powerful and compelling, is conditional, meaning it comes with conditions and expectations.

In short, where you see love (conditional) or the possibility of love, you are attracted. Conversely, you are naturally repulsed from where you do not see love--from where you see dislike or hate.

In everyday terms, love (conditional) equals pleasure, comfort, support, caring, niceness, harmony, peace, alignment, resonance, and so forth. On the other hand, we know that such love can also bring pain, separation, conflict, resentment, wounding, disappointment, and aloneness if the accompanying conditions and expectations are not satisfied and lived up to.

It is the same with companionship, beauty, grace, proportion, equity, and balance, i.e. we are attracted to where we see these things and repulsed from where we see do not see these things or, conversely, see only their opposites. This does not mean that where we do not see these things they do not exist; it simply means that we fail to see them--fail to see the greater Perfection of our lives and the world around us.

Nonetheless, Venus's emotional attractions and repulsions, alongside Mercury's mental attractions and repulsions and Mars's physical attractions and repulsions, make the world go around. They drive you this way and that along your life's path, along which you become the person you were meant to become in terms of your Divine Design.

However, these attractions and repulsions actually have you running around in circles, not evolving emotionally, because they are one-sided. To break out of these circles, you must bring together all sides of your emotional life into greater alignment and unity, which is part of the healing journey.

The alignment and unity of all polarized emotions--positive and negative and visible and hidden--is unconditional love, corresponding to Neptune.

VENUS IN ARIES

You will pursue a partner ardently and hastily, and yet strive for freedom and independence, once you are in an intimate relationship. You like to be the initiator in relationships, and can be aggressive. You may be a spendthrift.

VENUS IN THE 10TH HOUSE

You enjoy harmonious professional relationships, and can create beauty in your career. You may tend to perfectionism in your career.

17TH DEGREE OF ARIES

Part of Body: Vertebral canal

Sabian Symbol: Two prim spinsters sitting together in silence.

ASPECTS OF VENUS

Venus has no text available for aspects to subsequent chart points.

MARS (General)

Mars is the planet of drive, desires, motivation, intention, assertion, first steps, physical movement, the body, sensation, and sexuality. On the other hand, it is the planet of conflict, aggression, disagreement, war, materiality, anger, impatience, and unfinished tasks.

In short, Mars tells you what motivates you or not and how you are motivated or not, depending on its sign and house placements in your chart.

Not only are you motivated physically through Mars through sensations and through physical and sexual attractions and repulsions, but your emotional and mental attractions and repulsions (Moon, Venus, and Mercury) are also channeled through Mars inasmuch as these impulses usually result in physical actions of some sort.

When the impulses of your lower natures (physical, emotional, mental) become confused and conflicting, this is when the negative aspects of Mars manifest in you and in your life.

In its higher manifestation, Mars is about having and holding an intention toward a specific goal. Intention (Mars) works hand in hand with focused attention (Mercury) and emotional impulses (Venus) to basically make things happen in the world and in your life.

MARS IN CAPRICORN

You will pursue your personal desires in a responsible and methodical manner. You have strong ambitions, and may be domineering if threatened.

MARS IN THE 7TH HOUSE

You have a strong drive for intimate relationships. You like to remain independent within one-to-one relationships.

27TH DEGREE OF CAPRICORN

Part of Body: Deep nerves

Sabian Symbol: A mountain pilgrimage.

ASPECTS OF MARS

CONJUNCTION THE NORTH NODE Orb 5°49' Applying

You are being challenged to become assertive and focussed on your personal goals. Independence and self-confidence are keys to your growth in this life. You may find yourself thrust into leadership roles.

TRINE PLUTO Orb 2°11' Separating

You have a high energy level and a call to right the wrongs you see around you.

JUPITER (General)

Jupiter is the planet of expansion, abundance, adventure, travel, foreign places, philosophy, higher education, the Big Picture, wisdom, truth, your hidden Inner Child, and your potential Inner Sage.

Jupiter calls to you from across the asteroid belt, encouraging you, coaxing you, to break free from the limiting realms of the inner planets, which, in turn, relate to the mundane affairs of your daily life. Jupiter is an icon for your Quest for, and Journey toward a wider perspective, a more expansive and inclusive view, and a larger picture of your existence.

Jupiter relates to your Inner Child, which knows and remembers that the world and your life are exciting, magical, mysterious, and awe-inspiring--an adventure full of wonder and joy.

However, as you grew into adulthood, your Inner Child tended to become submerged, lost, and forgotten, covered by your wounds, issues, misperceptions, and illusions and by your judgments, blame, resentments, guilts, and fears. Jupiter is there to help you rediscover, reawaken, and reclaim your Inner Child.

Jupiter also relates to your Inner Sage, which will awaken and grow as you reconnect with your Inner Child. Your Inner Sage is initially the seeker of truth within you; ultimately, it is the all-knowing essence of Spirit that lies within each one of us.

While your wounds and issues remain unhealed and unresolved, though, with your Inner Child submerged and your Inner Sage unawakened, the filters of your lower natures will tend to distort Jupiter's energies, influences, and messages.

In this case, Jupiter is then also about excess, hyperbole, exaggeration, addiction, bombast, arrogance, soap-box preaching, fundamentalism, intolerance, spiritual-religious inflexibility, mania, and unrealistic dreams, plans, expectations, and conditions.

JUPITER IN AQUARIUS

You are a seeker of the new and inspirational. You hold racially-inclusive values, and are a humanitarian.

JUPITER IN THE 9TH HOUSE

You are conducting an insatiable search for the meaning of life. You have an endless quest for knowledge through philosophy, religion, study and travel. Expansive knowledge is the basis of your wisdom.

28TH DEGREE OF AQUARIUS

Part of Body: Right tibia

Sabian Symbol: A tree felled and sawed.

ASPECTS OF JUPITER

OPPOSITION URANUS Orb 3°48' Applying

You are keen to change things in this world as you see no reason to continue with the old traditions. You speak out against injustice, but may lack the patience and persistence to see through the changes.

SQUARE PLUTO Orb 2°45' Separating

You will need to learn to have confidence in yourself even when life deals you a few blows. You range from over confident to completely lacking in confidence. The truth lies somewhere in between.

SATURN (General)

Saturn is the planet of responsibility, seriousness, discipline, persistence, perseverance, effort, structure, boundaries, construction, order, laws, rules, regulations, management, control, organization, authority, business, calling, station, achievement, recognition, kudos, and awards.

On the other hand, it is the planet of limitations, restrictions, constriction, blockages, severity, strictness, repression, bondage, coldness, and conservatism.

Saturn asks you to take stock of yourself and your life, your assets and liabilities, your strengths and weaknesses, and your gifts and challenges. It asks you to consider where you have been or not been, what you have done or not done, where you are now, and where you might wish to be in the future. It asks you to take responsibility for yourself and your life--to get serious about it all, to take steps, to make plans, to make efforts, and to persevere until you achieve your goals.

Saturn tells you that you need to approach your spiritual life in the same way that you might approach your material life, i.e. with seriousness, planning, and discipline. Until you begin to take responsibility for your spiritual life, starting with your emotional wounds and issues, your way to the higher affairs of the outer planets will be barred.

(These higher affairs include accessing the larger picture of your life through Uranus, walking the path to unconditional love through Neptune, and activating self-initiated transformation and evolution of consciousness through Pluto.)

SATURN IN ARIES

You are resourceful, and capable of applying new methods in a practical manner. Your lessons are in patience and self-reliance.

SATURN IN THE 10TH HOUSE

You have a fear of public failure, and approach your career with caution. After early setbacks you will become hard-working and respectable in your chosen profession.

5TH DEGREE OF ARIES

Part of Body: The eyes, left and right

Sabian Symbol: A triangle with wings.

ASPECTS OF SATURN

Saturn has no text available for aspects to subsequent chart points.

CHIRON (General)

Chiron is the planet of wounding and healing. It mirrors and points to your deepest wounds and issues. These wounds and issues are usually formed in early childhood, but harken even back to unhealed and unresolved wounds and issues in past lives. (We are speaking energetically here, not in the sense of exact events or circumstances, as so-called past-life regressions would have us believe).

Your deepest wounds and issues--your voids--drive you this way and that in your life as you seek to escape from or heal their pain. At the same time, your voids determine your highest values, which also drive you this way and that in your life as you seek to find and live out these values.

Between the driving forces of your voids and values lies your perfect life's path. Along your life's path, you become who you are meant to become, eventually expressing, living out, and manifesting your Divine Design.

If Chiron is about your deepest wounds, it is also about your greatest gifts. Chiron says the Gift is the Wound. Your Divine Design is the Gift.

Chiron in your chart shows how your wounds manifest, how you react to these wounds, the potential path of your healing, and whether and how you may strive to rescue, soothe, and heal others and their pain. Chiron represents the Wounded Healer archetype.

CHIRON IN TAURUS

The Wound:

A deep insecurity. A core fear of losing safety, security, abundance, and/or love; the underlying conviction that these were taken away, were lost, were or are in deficit, and/or were or are missing. A loss of trust. A deficit of values.

The Search:

The search for security, safety, trust, and love, often mirrored through material values. The search for universal values.

The Wound's Expression:

Tendencies toward trying to grasp, hold on to, cling to, covet and/or hoard security, safety, abundance, and love, whether it is with respect to people, things, or core ideals. Tendencies toward being materially and/or emotionally demanding, clinging, and/or self-centered. Tendencies toward aligning self with transient values; alternately, devaluing self and life. Whatever form, though, it is all a quest for love.

Escaping the Wound:

Tendencies toward 1) clinging to material things and to emotionally safe and secure environments, 2) avoidance of risks, and/or 3) immersion in comfort and 'good living', yet 4) cautious with money.

The Healing Path:

Ultimately, we will realize that the safety, security, values, and love we seek are not to be found in the material world. They can only be found in the spiritual heart--in the wellspring of spirit and in the love that invisibly pervades all things.

In the meantime, our efforts to find and keep material safety, security, values, and love will gradually become decreasingly able to answer our needs. As Emerson said, nothing of the senses can ever satisfy. Abundance in the material world is but a reflection of the true abundance--that of the spiritual heart, of spirit, and of love. Love is the ultimate value.

The Gift:

Understanding the connection between the material and spiritual worlds. Learning how to manage and increase the abundance of the material world. Financial prudence, investing skill, management ability with material resources, steady persistence with these gifts, and a long-term perspective.

Ultimately, the gift is discovering, acknowledging, embracing, and loving the true wellspring of safety, security, abundance, and values, i.e. the spiritual heart, spirit, and love. The material world is the playground of spirit, the schoolroom of the higher self, and the mirror of the soul, ever enticing us to awaken.

The gift is a return to the trust that love will always be there, always is there, and was never missing. It is the realization that when we lose, we simultaneously gain--the universal law of conservation and compensation; also, that we cannot lose spirit or love, because it is eternal, omnipresent, and indestructible; it is us and we are it.

Roosevelt, Elizabeth Taylor, Tom Wolfe (writer), Burt Bacharach, Shirley Temple (Black), Sean Connery, Albert Einstein, Mata Hari, Audrey Hepburn, Grace Kelly, Jim Jones (Jonestown cult leader), Edward Kennedy, Rupert Murdoch, Willie Nelson, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, Ross Perot, Stephen Sondheim, Leopold Stokowski.

CHIRON IN THE 10TH HOUSE

Our woundedness is played out in the area of career, the public arena, business in general, mastery of our earthly purpose, and/or through our need for recognition, appreciation, respect, and acknowledgment of our achievements.

Example 1. Chiron in Sagittarius in the 10th house, say, might manifest as the pursuit of business, management, and/or public affairs as an answer to our wound of feeling that life is meaningless otherwise and holds no secrets other than what we can tangibly make of it. A sense of achievement and accolades give respite from our inner feelings of emptiness.

Example 2. Chiron in Gemini in the 10th house, say, might express as the wound of feeling intellectually stupid, ignorant, and/or unrecognized, expressed in a career

choice that is either physically and/or emotionally based, but not requiring too much thinking. Alternatively, it might be that our feeling of not being a good communicator or of being inept in social circumstances might be most prominently expressed in our chosen career, such as acting or politics (e.g. Woody Allen).

6TH DEGREE OF TAURUS

Part of Body: Larynx

Sabian Symbol: A bridge being built across a gorge.

ASPECTS OF CHIRON

SQUARE THE NORTH NODE Orb 2°48' Separating

Chiron-square-North Node indicates that our life's path/purpose/calling/destiny cannot proceed without us simultaneously attending to our wounds and issues. Because this is so, our life's path will necessarily have healing elements in it, for us and for others, whether we call it healing or not. As we deal with our wounds and issues (seen in Chiron's house and sign placement), our life's path/purpose/calling/destiny will necessarily reflect the healing lessons/experiences we have been through--for our benefit and for the benefit of others.

For example, let's suppose our life's path and its expression is to learn to communicate our inner wisdom (North Node in Sagittarius, South Node in Gemini). We will be unable to do this until we attend to the wounds that prevent us from accessing our inner wisdom (wounds represented in this example by Chiron in Pisces, where we shut the door on the universe and spirit, or by Chiron in Virgo, where we are so critical of ourselves that we cannot allow the outward expression of our seeming incompleteness). By attending to these wounds, the inner wisdom that we will ultimately communicate, according to our divine design, cannot help but have elements of healing knowledge and a healing effect upon others.

Examples of the aspect include Amelia Earhart, Al Pacino and Victor Hugo.

SQUARE THE SOUTH NODE Orb 2°48' Separating

(See Chiron square North Node, above...)

URANUS (General)

Uranus is the planet of revelation, revolutionary ideas, innovation, experimentation, higher logic, and genius; it is about originality, the unconventional, the unexpected, and the unusual; it is the reconciler and unifier of opposites, polarities, and contradictions; it is about putting together the pieces of the larger blueprint of your life, the world around you, and the universe at large; and it is about the confounding and astounding answers to seemingly unanswerable and illogical questions, such as those presented in Zen koans, like, "What is the sound of one hand clapping?"

Uranus tells you that your ordinary mind--your lower mental nature--cannot grasp the higher logic of your life without bringing together all the complementary opposites of the world into a greater unity. The sum of the parts is greater than the whole; the synergy

of the parts combined creates something entirely new and unexpected, like combining iron and carbon to make steel.

To grasp Uranus's higher logic, you are required to bring together all your "organs" of perception--your physical, emotional, and mental natures--into greater alignment and unity. From this "blending" comes a new and higher nature within you--a higher consciousness, an expanded awareness--that has the capacity to see and connect with the larger blueprint of your existence.

While your wounds and issues remain unhealed and unresolved, though, the filters of your lower natures will tend to distort Uranus's energies, influences, and messages. The result can be rebelliousness, perversity, perversion, extremism, deliberate contrariety, conflict, unpredictability, unreliability, and irrationality.

URANUS IN VIRGO

(1962 - 1968) It is important to note that Uranus spends a long time in each sign, and therefore the interpretation applies to a generation rather than the individual. For a more individual interpretation look at the house position. This is the generation which starts to focus on the practical details of humanity. Medical research, the balance between work and leisure, the links between mind and body come into focus.

URANUS IN THE 3RD HOUSE

You are a quick and original thinker. You enjoy studying unusual subjects, which you approach in your own original way. You may have an unusual relationship with your siblings.

2ND DEGREE OF VIRGO

Part of Body: Small intestine

Sabian Symbol: A large white cross stands alone on top of a high hill.

ASPECTS OF URANUS

TRINE CHIRON Orb 4°15' Separating

The last two Chiron-Uranus trines occurred in 1945-1946 and 1994-95--both instances occurring very close to Chiron's perigee and perihelion (closest point to the Earth and the Sun, respectively) in Libra (in 1945 and 1996). This makes it difficult to separate the interpretation of this trine from the interpretation of the perigee/perihelion in Libra.

In general, though, Chiron-trine-Uranus brings our wounds and issues into sharp focus, much the way the Chiron-Uranus opposition does. However, it does so in a more harmonious way inasmuch as it offers us easier access to Uranus's higher perspectives--to the underlying logic behind our wounds and issues.

Having said this, though, this trine combined with Chiron's perigee/perihelion can make us feel naked--our wounds and issues exposed and vulnerable. The result is that we tend to run away from our wounds and issues and toward Uranus--toward technology, global networking and communications, and humanitarian themes; if we cannot fix ourselves, we try to fix the world and make it a better place in which to live, driven by our individual and collective feeling of inadequacy. (The general modern view that humans are messing up the planet is an example of this psychological tendency.)

This trine gives us an enormous opportunity to delve into our wounds and issues.

Whether we take advantage of the opportunity or not will depend on the other aspects in our charts and upon our general willingness (or not) to attend to our wounds and issues.

Persons born during the 1945-46 trine represent the advance scouts, so to speak, of the coming shift of consciousness of the 1960s. Many were actively involved in this shift, being, as they were, in college at the time during the mid-1960s.

In a sense, those born during this trine (1945-46) fell dramatically into two camps. The first camp consisted of the advance scouts of the coming “new age” (Chiron in Libra); the second camp consisted of those who birthed the technological, information, and communications eras (Uranus in Gemini).

Those born during the 1994-95 trine have yet to blossom into measurable trends and patterns. We can predict, however, that these children will contribute, in their later years, to two vastly polarized trends as we approach the next Chiron apogee/aphelion of 2020-21. Some will turn toward a fresh “new age” movement. They will gravitate back to spirituality and global consciousness; this time, however, it will have a more practical basis than the previous “new age” (Chiron in Libra again and, to a lesser degree, Uranus in Capricorn/Aquarius). Others will favor the practical and economic path (Uranus in Capricorn/Aquarius) and will seek to solidify, secure, and protect the material, economic, social, and political state of the world as it becomes increasingly global in outlook.

This aspect can be a tacit indication of considerable work already done on healing and evolution of consciousness in past lives.

It can also be a welcome addition to the charts of those wishing to pursue healing as a life’s path--for themselves and/or for others.

Noted people with this trine aspect of Chiron and Uranus include James Joyce, Barry Gibb, Bill Clinton, Donald Trump, Franklin D. Roosevelt (1882 trine), Goldie Hawn, Oscar Wilde, Stuart Wilde (new age teacher and speaker), Lorne Johndro (Canadian astrologer interested in the research of electromagnetic fields and their astrological correspondence), Antoine Becquerel (French physicist, whose early studies were concerned with the magnetic and polarization properties of light. He shared the Nobel Prize in physics with Pierre and Marie Curie in 1903 for the discovery of radioactivity), Jules Massenet (French composer) and William Blake (poet and visionary, 1757 trine).

NEPTUNE (General)

Neptune is the planet of spirituality, mysticism, and unconditional love. It is about at-onement, which comes from atonement taken in its highest sense.

Atonement means acknowledging, accepting, forgiving, embracing, and finally unconditionally loving those people, events, circumstances, and things in you, your life, and the world around you that you may still be judging, condemning, resenting, blaming, rejecting, disowning, projecting, and otherwise holding on to. It means realizing that all things and all people are essentially connected and come from the same essential Oneness of Spirit, however you might conceive of this. Neptune says, I am you, you are me, and we all are Spirit on a journey back to our divine origins.

From this perspective, Neptune represents the higher octave of your emotional nature.

However, any unhealed wounds and unresolved issues tend to filter and distort Neptune's energies and influences. This can blur the lines between reality and fantasy; it can cause confusion, distortion, misperceptions, blurred boundaries, and illusions. These things, in turn, can either thwart your path to higher consciousness or impel you to take up the quest for higher consciousness--for growth, healing, transformation, and the attainment of unconditional love.

NEPTUNE IN TAURUS

(1874/75 - 1887/89) It is important to note that Neptune takes about 164 years to make a complete cycle, spending about thirteen years in each sign. Therefore the interpretation of Neptune in the Sign applies to a generation rather than the individual. For a more individual interpretation look at the house position. This generation possesses the ability to apply spiritual values to the realms of money and resources. They can be practical about mystical insights. Beautiful art and objects may reflect the spiritual world.

NEPTUNE IN THE 10TH HOUSE

You yearn to be of service through your profession. You may experience a sense of loss surrounding your chosen life direction. You may be required to sacrifice your chosen career in some way.

8TH DEGREE OF TAURUS

Part of Body: Cervical nerves

Sabian Symbol: A sleigh without snow.

ASPECTS OF NEPTUNE

CONJUNCTION CHIRON Orb 2°19' Applying

Chiron conjunct, parallel, contra-parallel, or occult Neptune (1879-80, 1945, and 2010) produces a resonant channel between our soul (and its experience of unconditional love) and our lower nature (and its attendant wounds and issues).

Depending on our level of healing and evolution of consciousness, this can affect us in one of two ways (or a proportional balance of both ways):

In its lowest expression, it can entirely disassociate us from reality and make it virtually impossible for us to touch the ground, so to speak. The result will tend to be escapist patterns and behavior. It may result in indulgence in drugs, alcohol, and other mind-numbing pursuits; it may manifest as social misconduct and/or dysfunction; it may cause us to seek out sectarian religions, cults, and fringe groups; and/or it may result in psychopathy.

In its highest expression, this aspect can confer extraordinary healing ability and focus. It can be the mark of a mystic, saint, or prophet. It can also be the mark of genius, because, if we can bear our wounds and issues, we are directly connected to our soul. Such assertions are evidenced by the fact that Edgar Cayce (the "Sleeping Prophet"), Albert Einstein, and Michelangelo share this aspect.

The less evolved we are, the more likely this aspect will manifest its lower expression. Conversely, the more evolved we are, the more likely this aspect will manifest its higher expression. In truth, each of us will have both higher and lower expressions, manifesting to differing degrees in different areas of our lives.

Ultimately, this aspect creates a deep need to connect with spirit as an answer to our woundedness. Through this aspect, Neptune encourages us to unconditionally love our wounds and issues--love the lost, disowned, denied, and otherwise negatively judged pieces of ourselves--and bring them lovingly back into the light.

This aspect can be a tacit indication of considerable work already done on healing and evolution of consciousness in past lives.

In the charts of persons wishing to pursue healing as a life's path--for themselves and/or for others--this aspect is a welcome addition.

Moreover, this aspect can confer extraordinary healing ability and focus, particularly when combined with other significant Chiron aspects.

PLUTO (General)

Pluto is the planet of transformation, death, rebirth, destruction, regeneration, revolution, war, evolution, and transcendence. It wipes away the old in our lives, making way for the new. It shows us that all forms are transient, but teaches us that the essence behind all forms is eternal; the universe is an eternal play of forms, expressing the eternal Spirit behind all appearances.

Pluto's energies and influences come in dramatic and life-changing ways, both globally and personally. These energies and influences are unstoppable, immutable, and all-pervasive, like a tsunami bearing down upon us, engulfing everything in its path.

Pluto is about global changes, crises, cataclysms, revolutions, and movements of consciousness. It is about the evolution of the consciousness of humanity as it gradually shakes itself free of attachments to forms and appearances. Behind every major global shift of consciousness lies Pluto, working together with the other outer planets, Saturn, Chiron, Uranus, and Neptune.

Without Pluto's consciousness-changing upheavals in our lives, personally and globally, there would be no evolution, no progress, and no return to our divine origins in Spirit.

PLUTO IN TAURUS

(1852 - 1884) It is important to note that Pluto takes about 248 years to make a complete cycle, spending 12 to 32 years in each sign. Therefore the interpretation of Pluto in its sign applies to a generation rather than the individual. For a more individual interpretation look at the house position. This is the generation of economic change. They possess the ability to transform material production and monetary processes.

PLUTO IN THE 11TH HOUSE

You may feel drawn to powerful political groups, and experience powerful conflict with friends. You also have the ability to form deep and profound friendships.

25TH DEGREE OF TAURUS

Part of Body: Lower jaw

Sabian Symbol: A large well-kept public park.

ASPECTS OF PLUTO

Pluto has no aspects to subsequent chart points.

THE ASCENDANT (General)

Initially, the Ascendant or Rising Sign indicates how you see yourself; i.e. it relates to your self-image. It also has a lot to do with how people see you upon first meeting. And it is about how you express yourself through gesture, expression, posture, movement, dress, and style.

From a higher perspective, the Ascendant is the "window" or interface between your innermost and truest self and the world around you. However, how you see yourself tends to color the glass, so to speak, masking your innermost self.

As you mature, though, and maybe attend to your journey of self-discovery, this window tends to clear, so that your innermost and truest self can shine through without the need for masks or filters. Furthermore, the higher qualities of the Ascendant may then blend with the qualities of your innermost self.

All in all, the Ascendant is a key to self-discovery.

THE ASCENDANT IN CANCER

Caring for others provides your key for self-expression. Life can also be met with strong internalised emotions and a tenacious regard for family and tradition. You are sensitive and easily hurt, and can build a protective wall if you feel vulnerable.

THE ASCENDANT IN THE 1ST HOUSE

The ascendant forms the 1st house cusp in most house systems, so this placement has no particular meaning.

12TH DEGREE OF CANCER

Part of Body: Greater curvature of stomach

Sabian Symbol: A chinese woman nursing a baby with a message.

ASPECTS OF THE ASCENDANT

The Ascendant has no text available for aspects to subsequent chart points.

THE MIDHEAVEN (General)

The Midheaven (or MC) is about your public life. It is about recognition, social status, your chosen profession, vocation, and calling. This relates to your destiny or life's path (which can be seen in the Nodes of the Moon).

The Midheaven can tell you how your life, vocation, or calling will contribute to, and be seen by the world--whether you will stand out, making your mark, so to speak, or whether your life and calling will be played out more behind the scenes.

THE MIDHEAVEN IN PISCES

You will serve humanity through your career. You may suffer through changes of profession, and chase fantasies about your life direction. You may feel overwhelmed by career decisions.

THE MIDHEAVEN IN THE 10TH HOUSE

The midheaven forms the 10th house cusp in most house systems, so this placement has no particular meaning.

13TH DEGREE OF PISCES

Part of Body: Plantar artery of left foot

Sabian Symbol: A sword in a museum.

ASPECTS OF THE MIDHEAVEN

The Midheaven has no aspects to subsequent chart points.

THE SOUTH NODE

THE SOUTH NODE IN LEO

This is a quest towards service to humankind. You will experience a struggle between your own personal needs and a sense of dedication to others. You need to lay aside your personal need for honor and prestige and use your talents to serve the world.

THE SOUTH NODE IN THE 1ST HOUSE

This is a quest for right relations. You need to let go of ego-centred actions and devote your life to others.

3RD DEGREE OF LEO

Part of Body: Right coronary artery

Sabian Symbol: A woman having her hair bobbed.

ASPECTS OF THE SOUTH NODE

The South Node has no aspects to subsequent chart points.
